We hope that everybody is having a great season of winter basketball and enjoyed the holidays. We are excited about our upcoming 2012 Spring/Summer AAU basketball program for athletes living in San Francisco and the surrounding Bay Area.

The Bay City Basketball Program features an experienced and enthusiastic coaching staff. It is the goal of this club to provide top-notch coaching for all of our teams. The club will feature participation in competitive leagues and/or tournaments, individual and team instruction and an up-tempo aggressive style of play. Based on player demand, we will form boy's and girl's teams for fourth through twelfth graders. The goal of the club is to teach aspiring athletes the fundamentals of the game and develop their team and individual skills in a competitive atmosphere. Players in the Bay City Basketball Program are highly committed and serious about getting better at basketball. Spring/Summer 2011 Season Commitment: All teams will practice once or twice a week in the late afternoon or early evening on weekdays in one of our San Francisco gym locations. The teams will participate in 20-25 games on weekends, March through July. These games will come in the form of seven to eight tournaments. Most of the tournaments will be local, with a maximum travel location of Sacramento or Reno. Each tournament will consist of a minimum of three games and the possibility of a fourth based on team performance. Once the teams have been formed, a detailed practice and game schedule will be made available.

Tryout Date: Tryouts will be hosted on March 10th and 11th in San Francisco. The location and time for each grade are still to be determined. Please add these dates to your calendar. We will evaluate all players during the workout. It is our goal to form two competitive teams for each grade level whenever possible.

Team Travel Option: Some teams in our program are more competitive and may be traveling more than others. For some teams there will be an option to travel to Las Vegas in July. In this case each player will have to pay an additional fee to help with airfare and coaches' accommodations (an estimated \$75 per player). Not all teams will be offered this option.

Program Cost: Players earning a spot on one of the Bay City Basketball Club Teams pay fees that will cover all costs including coaching, gym time, administrative fees, tournament fees and insurance.

The cost for the 2011 Spring/Summer program (March 11 – Aug 1).

- \$850 for returning players
- \$950 for new players
- \$150 for a home and away game uniform. All teams are getting new uniforms for 2012. These newly designed high quality stitched uniforms have names on the back and will be personalized for each player. We plan to wear these uniforms for two years.
